#### VERIFIED JOINT PETITION TO MODIFY SERVICE AREA BOUNDARIES

Indianapolis Power & Light Company d/b/a AES Indiana ("AES Indiana") and Hancock Rural Telephone Corporation d/b/a NineStar Connect ("NineStar"), jointly petition the Indiana Utility Regulatory Commission ("Commission") to approve Joint Petitioners' agreement to change a portion of their assigned service area boundaries located on U.S.G.S. Facet Map Q-16 and state in support of this request that:

1. Joint Petitioner AES Indiana is a corporation organized and existing under the laws of the State of Indiana, with its principal place of business located in Indianapolis, Marion County, Indiana. It is engaged in the business of distributing, furnishing and selling retail electric service to the public in several counties in the State of Indiana, including Hancock County, and has charter authority to do so.

2. Joint Petitioner NineStar is the surviving entity following the merger of Hancock Rural Telephone Corporation and Hancock Rural Electric Membership Corporation pursuant to Ind. Code § 8-1-17.5-1 *et seq.* NineStar is a member-owned cooperative that provides, in part, electric distribution services. It is duly organized and existing under the laws of the State of Indiana with its principal place of business at 2243 E. Main Street, Greenfield, Indiana 46140. It is engaged in the business of distributing, furnishing and selling retail electric service to the public in several counties in the State of Indiana, including Hancock County, and has legal authority to do so.

3. Each of the Joint Petitioners is an "electricity supplier" as defined in Ind. Code § 8-1-2.3-2, and the provisions of Ind. Code § 8-1-2.3-1 *et seq.* are deemed applicable to the subject matter of this Joint Petition.

4. The initial assigned service area boundaries between Joint Petitioners on U.S.G.S. Facet Map Q-16 were approved by this Commission in Cause No. 36299-S215(CB)(X). The Hancock County, Indiana property that is the subject of this Joint Petition consists of property located on U.S.G.S. Facet Map Q-16 that is located in McCordsville, Indiana.

5. The proposed boundary change located on U.S.G.S. Facet Map Q-16 is identified on the attached map marked for purposes of identification as <u>Exhibit A</u>. The requested boundary change will result in a small area of NineStar's service territory, approximately three (3) acres, to become part of AES Indiana's service area. In addition, approximately 7.5 acres of AES Indiana's service territory will become part of NineStar's service area. The proposed boundary line changes will not require a change in the electricity supplier for existing customers of either utility.

6. Modification of the assigned service area boundaries as proposed herein will not cause the duplication of facilities, waste of materials or resources, or uneconomic, inefficiency or inadequate electric service to the public, consistent with Ind. Code § 8-1-2.3-6(2).

8. In accordance with Ind. Code § 8-1-2.3-6(2), Joint Petitioners will publish notice of this change in a newspaper of general circulation in Boone County, Indiana. See <u>Exhibit B</u> for a copy of said notice. Further in accordance with 170 IAC 1-1.1-9, AES Indiana will post the Legal Notice on its Company website located at https://www.aesindiana.com/ and NineStar will post the Legal Notice on its Company website located at www.ninestarconnect.com, where each Legal Notice will remain for at least thirty (30) days following a Final Order in this Cause.

9. Joint Petitioners will submit the proofs of publication of notice and a Proposed Order promptly following publication of the notices.

10. As requested in Appendix A to the Commission's September 28, 2006 Order in Cause No. 42868, the technical representative for AES Indiana is Kevin Walker and his phone number is (317) 261-8196, and the technical representative for NineStar is Ryan Bewley and his phone number is (317) 323-2084.

11. The Joint Petitioners agree to work with the Commission staff to update the Commission GIS maps, in accordance with any approval of boundary changes.

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WHEREFORE, AES Indiana and NineStar respectfully request that the Commission, pursuant to Ind. Code § 8-1-2.3-6(2), after 20 days and if no affected electricity customer requests a hearing, enter an order in this proceeding, without a hearing, permanently approving the changes to the service area boundaries on U.S.G.S. Facet Map Q-16 as proposed in this Joint Petition and identified in Exhibit A, and grant such other and further relief to the Joint Petitioners as may be appropriate.


